Farmers in the Mediterranean area and climate change adaptation

The objective of the LIFE Clinicics Project is to increase the resilience of the local Mediterranean entities through intervention in three territories —Montseny, Terres de l'Ebre and Penedès— and three economic activities —tourism, agroforestry and fishing.

Resilience is a concept that will be increasingly present and is defined as the ability to adapt to changes and adverse situations. The more resilience, the more resistant we will be to the impacts of climate change.

Climate change is a reality. We need to know how to adapt to the effects that we already suffer, but we must also be able to predict those that will come. These impacts affect the natural systems, and at the same time the health of people

and economic activities. Preventing and reducing vulnerability shall be the best adaptation strategy.
